HOSPITAL/HEALTH/MEDICAL BENEFITS -LIABILITY OF INSURER TO PAY

Under the provisions of the *Victims of Crime Assistance Act* 1996, the Tribunal has determined that **all** Medical and Health Insurers are obliged to meet their liabilities fully <u>before</u> the Tribunal will make any order for expenses incurred.

The Victims of Crime Assistance Tribunal takes the view that "any form of insurance" includes *any* form of health or medical benefits.
