

Guideline No. 2 of 2019

FEES FOR THE PREPARATION OF REPORTS AND PROVISION OF COUNSELLING SERVICES

Purpose

This Guideline is issued by the Chief Magistrate pursuant to section 45(1A) of the *Victims of Crime Assistance Act 1996* for the purpose of guiding Tribunal Members and Registrars in awarding financial assistance for expenses relating to counselling reports and sessions. A Tribunal Member may depart from this Guideline in appropriate circumstances.

Scope

This Guideline applies to all awards for counselling made on and after the commencement date, and for reports filed on or after the commencement date.

Related documents

This Guideline should be read in conjunction with the Chief Magistrate's Practice Directions 1 of 2014 regarding procedures to be followed by treating counsellors (psychologists and non-psychologists) and Practice Direction 2 of 2014 regarding procedures to follow in the preparation and filing of assessment reports prepared by a psychologist who will not be providing treatment/counselling.
