# How can VOCAT help you?

If you are eligible for financial assistance VOCAT may be able to pay your reasonable expenses related to the incident, including:

- cultural support to help you with your healing
- urgent financial assistance
- medical and dental services
- counselling
- safety and security
- loss of earnings
- funeral costs
- other expenses to assist in your recovery, in certain circumstances.

# **Urgent financial assistance**

You can seek urgent financial assistance for expenses such as funeral costs, counselling, medical, or safety related expenses.

# Help with the VOCAT process

VOCAT staff are culturally sensitive to your needs and will help you and your family on your journey to heal.

VOCAT has Koori registrars who will provide guidance throughout the application process and can refer you to other culturally appropriate support agencies if you need extra support.

The Tribunal can pay for legal costs to assist you with your VOCAT application.
